Dear Mr. Rhines the California Medical
Facility (CMF) was built in the early 1960's
and is old dilapidated and falling apart
daily, especially the gym. It's ceiling has
holes that when it rains staff has to put over
50 buckets down to catch rain water, there's
a strong odor of ferment eaten wood and
dark brown stains dripping down the walls.
I consulted officers and medical nurses
and doctors who confirm it is "Asbestos" and
"Black Mold". I documented the dates and
times I saw Asbestos abatement trucks
park long trailers next to the buildings as

workers dressed in white protection with face masks on top of the roofs tossing stuff down into those long bins.

The buildings have built-in steam like heat radiating to keep the cells warm as they get very cold at night with maintenance shuts off the heat to do repairs which is often.

White puff is gray and I was informed by maintenance crews that it is asbestos. In March 15, 2018 this prison was under quarantine due to epidemic spread of "H1N1" (norovirus) in which former warden Fox issued a memorandum to this effect.

Mr. Rhines, I don't know if your familiar with CDC exposing prisoners to "Valley Fever" See (b)(6) Privacy, (b)(7)(c) Ent. Privacy v. Schwarzenegger et al. Ninth Circuit Case No. 15-17155 Eastern Dist Case No. 1:14-cv-00-150-54B, etc.

CDC officials violated the Equal Protection Clause of the 14th Amendment by intentionally failing to protect African-American inmates whom the officials knew had a heightened risk of developing disseminated "valley".

I am an African American with upper respiratory infection.

I suffered two strokes due to a drug

and medical doctors prescribed called

and failed to warn me of the dangers

injuries that include internal bleeding, gastric-

testes, cerebral bleeding, cerebral

bleeding, stroke, hemorrhagic stroke, subdural

hematoma, hemorrhagic thrombocytopenic purpura,

and possible - death. I do not want to die

Mr. Rhines. I am sentenced under the

and three strikes law that targeted blacks

for mass incarceration for non-violent crimes.

I committed a nonviolent burglary and received

35 years to life. I served 21 years already

and have numerous medical conditions.

I am 55 years old now with after and

lower back problems due to the strokes I
