Dear Secretary Regan:

On January 30, 2017, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) External Civil Rights Compliance Office (ECRCO) was informed that the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality (NC DEQ) and the Complainants, the North Carolina Environmental Justice Network, Rural Empowerment Association for Community Help (REACH) and the Waterkeeper Alliance, Inc., represented by Earthjustice, agreed to engage in Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR). On March 2, 2017, NC DEQ and the Complainants agreed upon the selection of a mediator. In light of this information, ECRCO has suspended its investigation of the subject Complaint for the duration of the ADR process. ECRCO will resume its investigation if the parties do not reach resolution through ADR.
