During a June 17, 2016 phone conversation with Laura Bachle and Jeremy Lofthouse, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Office of Civil Rights (OCR) received additional information from you reflecting that the circumstances that had originally prompted you to send this correspondence had changed. Specifically, you indicated that local government or another entity had taken action to address and resolve concerns regarding the nuisance odor from the factory farms southwest of your residence.
