

Reporting under Clean Air Act (CAA) Section 608

CAA: Section 608 Reporting Requirements



- Under CAA Section 608 (40 CFR Part 82, Subpart F), EPA-certified reclaimers must report the following quantities for both ozone-depleting substances (ODS) and hydrofluorocarbons (HFCs), and submit to the EPA by February 1 of the following calendar year:
 - Total annual quantity of material (i.e., the combined mass of refrigerant and contaminants) by refrigerant type received for reclamation
 - Total annual mass of each refrigerant reclaimed
 - Total annual mass of waste products
- 608 reports can be submitted via CDX (preferred) or via the 608reports@epa.gov mailbox.

CAA: Troubleshooting Section 608 Reports



- Submit data in kilograms (kg).
 - Also ensure your company is using an appropriate conversion factor (e.g., 2.20462 Lbs \rightarrow 1 Kg).
- If prompted to resubmit a CAA Section 608 report, please resubmit a **complete** report including your company's complete ODS and HFC figures.
- Report all mixed refrigerants as the estimated quantities of individual HFCs and ODS components that are salvageable within those mixtures.
- Update the EPA if your company's reporting contact info changes.

Submitting Reports Electronically via CDX

CDX Overview




- What is CDX?
 - The Central Data Exchange (CDX) is the password-protected online platform used by EPA for electronic reporting.
 - Submitting 608 data in this format is more secure and manageable for the Agency.
- Who needs to register?
 - First-time CDX users who do not have a CDX account.
 - Existing CDX users who have a CDX account but are not registered with the ODS program.
 - If you are currently registered to report information in HAWK¹ under the AIM Act, your login information can be used to access CDX.


1 The HFC and ODS Allowance Tracking (HAWK) reporting module is the platform reclaimers use to submit quarterly reporters required under 40 CFR Part 84 Subpart A.



Viewing a Submitted Report




- Go to https://cdx.epa.gov/ and log into your CDX account.
- From the "MyCDX" tab, select "Ozone Depleting Substances."






• From the CDX ODS home page, select "Other Documents."

What Is a Passphrase?

- An encryption key that protects the contents of your submission.
- You must create one each time you create a new submission.
- You are permitted to use the same passphrase for all submissions.
- A single passphrase may be used by all CDX users in your organization(s).






- Upload Documents.

 - Remove documents by clicking on the red 'X' in the far-right column.






- You may save your submission at any time and complete and submit the report at a later date.
- To complete an "in progress" submission, locate the report in the Submission History table and click on the "Report ID" link.
- Enter the passphrase and click "Next" to return to the report.
- Confirm information and then click "Save and Submit."
- Review your Submission for completeness and accuracy and then click "Sign, Encrypt, and Submit."







- Certify the accuracy of your submission by clicking "Accept."
- Complete the eSignature by entering your CDX account password, answering the verification question, and clicking "Sign."



Viewing Your Reclaimer Report




- Locate the report to review from the CDX home page.

HFC Allocation Program Reporting Under the AIM Act

HFC Allocation Program Reporting Requirements



- HFC reporting and recordkeeping requirements are codified in 40 CFR part 84.
- All reports are to be submitted quarterly to the EPA through the HFC and ODS Allowance Tracking (HAWK) reporting module, within the electronic Greenhouse Gas Reporting Tool (e-GGRT).

Reporting Period	Covered Period	Reports Due
Quarter 1	January 1–March 31	May 15
Quarter 2	April 1–June 30	August 14
Quarter 3	July 1–September 30	November 14
Quarter 4	October 1– December 31	February 14
