

Common Markings During the Phase 1 Process

These are some common signs and markings showing EPA has inspected your property:



White signage and stake = a site has been cleared of hazardous material (HM) and is completed



White symbols (= , X, X↑) on trees = Hangers or loose limb, may be dangerous in high winds. Keep safe distance.
White "T" = Property assessed for trees



White paint or "X" mark = Empty HM containers or containers to be left in place and removed in Phase 2



Pink paint = Suspected asbestos containing material



Blue lightning bolt

Electric vehicle (EV) damaged.

White and blue lightning

bolt = EV battery removed.



White "O" mark on hood of vehicle = Non-electric vehicle (EV) with battery
White "X" on hood of vehicle

= Non-EV battery removed



Red "X" on Battery
Storage Systems = Needs
removal
White "X" on top of red
"X" = removal complete



Orange paint = Septic system location, damaged transformer, or high hazard item left on site
