## INTERGOVERNMENTAL REVIEW INSTRUCTIONS NEW JERSEY APPLICANTS

EXECUTIVE ORDER 12372 The Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) regulation, <u>40 CFR</u> Part 29, sets forth the Agency's obligations and procedures for consulting with and responding to views expressed by State and local elected officials on proposed EPA direct development activities, and applications submitted for EPA financial assistance.

EPA's Office of Grants and Debarment has published <u>RAIN-2021-G02</u> EPA Intergovernmental Review. This RAIN informs recipients and applicants about how to determine which EPA financial assistance programs and activities are subject to Intergovernmental Review (IR) requirements. Please visit <u>EPA grant programs and activities by Assistance Listing Number that</u> <u>are subject to intergovernmental review (full list)</u>.

Please note that programs which are subject to intergovernmental review for policy reasons rather than the requirements of Section 204 of the Demonstration Cities and Metropolitan Development Act and Section 401 of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act are identified with an asterisk (\*).

On November 24, 2020, EPA issued a <u>Federal Register Notice</u> providing the list of EPA financial assistance programs and activities subject to intergovernmental review. The list reflects EPA's determination that state applicants for State Revolving Fund (SRF) capitalization grants meet their 40 CFR Part 29 IR responsibilities when the state complies with the public notice requirements for Intended Use Plans (IUP) in 40 CFR 35.3150 or 40 CFR 35.3555 as applicable. The IUP regulations implement the statutory requirements at CWA 1386(c) and SDWA 1452(b) for IUPs.

State applicants for SRF funding need not follow the IR procedures in 40 CFR Part 29. Please check box "c" on Standard Form 424 Question 19, indicating that the application is not subject to the E.O. 12372 IR procedures per EPA's determination. See Figure 1.

Due to the elimination of the State Clearinghouse function in the State of New York, it is now necessary for each applicant for EPA Region 2 funding that impacts New York to submit their application to the relevant State, County, and Area wide reviewing agencies.

A list of these agencies, along with their addresses, are found below. At a minimum, your application should be submitted to the listed agency in your county and other counties impacted. Please note that New York State Department of Environmental Conservation has waived its right to review. Please refer to the list of counties participating in the review process.

After submitting your application to Grants.gov, you should send the reviewing agencies a letter or email transmitting your application review package. Also include the first page of the application (SF-424) and a project summary describing the activities proposed to be funded.

Please provide proof of your Intergovernmental Review by forwarding a copy of the email or letter submitted to each reviewing agency to <u>Region2\_GrantApplicationBox@epa.gov</u>. Reviewing agencies should submit comments to this email as well. Please be sure to give the agencies a deadline for comments at least 30 days from the day they receive the application.

Please note that EPA cannot complete processing of the application until the intergovernmental review process has been completed. If you need additional information about this process, please email <u>Region2\_GrantApplicationBox@epa.gov</u>.
