We are former employees of the Maryland Transit Administration (MTA), which is listed as one of five Administrations under the Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT).

We would like to meet with your office to discuss possible Title VI violations of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. We believe that an overwhelming percentage of females (a protected class) have been disproportionately laid off due to budget cuts within an agency that is male-dominated and that is still hiring employees in vacant or new open positions.
