**Re: Referral of Administrative Complaint**

Dear Mr. Alston:

On August 27, 2012, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Office of Civil Rights (OCR), received a complaint from an inmate at the Five Points Correctional Facility, which is managed by the New York State Department of Corrections and Community Supervision (NYS DOCCS). The complaint alleged that the Five Points Correctional Facility: 1) failed to provide cigarette butt cans in staff smoking facilities, posing a threat to human life and wildlife; 2) disposed of trash in large, cheap trash bags which were left outside overnight, posing a threat to crows and seagulls; and, 3) used mentally disabled inmates to pick up cigarette butts by hand. Neither Five Points Correctional Facility nor the NYS DOCCS are recipients of EPA financial assistance. Therefore, the complaint is not within EPA OCR jurisdiction to investigate, and OCR must reject the complaint for investigation.

However, because the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) may have subject matter expertise over the allegations in this complaint, the complaint is being referred to DOJ to review and investigate as you deem appropriate. We have notified the complainant that his complaint has been forwarded to DOJ and provided him with your contact information.
