COMMENTS

I am Native American living on the Oneida Indian Reservation in Wisconsin. We have a garbage disposal problem and I am hereby filing a formal complaint. Within the last two months I have avoided at least two accidents as a result of garbage truck traffic and traffic avoiding garbage containers on the roadway. What is the problem? The Oneida Tribe contracts for garbage pickup from one vendor and [REDACTED] contracts from another vendor so truck traffic to pick up garbage is twice what it should be. For example I have my garbage out on Friday and my neighbor has his out to the road on Wednesday. The garbage goes to the same place. Consider, "Cost-effectiveness requires that the least of amount of resources be used to achieve an objective" (Callan & Thomas, 2013, p. 19).

In summary, it is not only dangerous to have separate garbage disposal but also a resource waste.

Please keep me informed as you move through this complaint.
