This letter is in response to your calls to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Office of Civil Rights (OCR). Your administrative complaint was originally filed with the United States Department of Justice (DOJ), referred to the EPA on August 5, 2010, and received on September 1, 2010. The complaint alleged that the EPA Region 4, Tronox Incorporated, and the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) violated Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended (Title VI), 42 U.S.C. §§ 2000d et seq., and the EPA's nondiscrimination regulations implementing Title VI found at 40 C.F.R. Part 7.
