R. 15-1, Salt River Agricultural Improvement and Power District ("SRP") and Tucson Electric Power Company ("TEP") hereby petition this Court for review of the final rule of respondents United States Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") and Lee Michael Zeldin, EPA Administrator, entitled "Partial Approval and Disapproval of Air Quality

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Implementation Plans; Arizona; Regional Haze State Implementation Plan for the Second Implementation Period and Prong 4 (Visibility) for the 2015 Ozone and 2012 Particulate Matter Standards," published in the Federal Register at 89 Fed. Reg. 102,744 (Dec. 18, 2024). A copy of EPA's final rule is attached as Exhibit A. This Court has jurisdiction, and is the proper venue for this action, under 42 U.S.C. § 7607(b)(1) because SRP and TEP are petitioning for review of an implementation plan promulgated under 42 U.S.C. § 7410 that is applicable only to Arizona.
