Re: Referral of Administrative Correspondence

Dear Mr. Rosenbaum:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), External Civil Rights Compliance Office (ECRCO) is referring a complaint received September 12, 2016 from a prisoner incarcerated at the Polk Correctional Institution (Polk CI), operated by the North Carolina Department of Public Safety (NCDPS). The complaint against Polk CI alleges that the Complainant and other prisoners at Polk CI are living in unsanitary conditions including floors caked in bodily fluids. ECRCO cannot accept this complaint for investigation, because neither Polk CI nor NCDPS are recipients of EPA financial assistance. As this complaint does not fall within ECRCO's jurisdiction, ECRCO must reject the complaint and close it as the date of this letter.

As the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) may have jurisdiction over Polk CI and/or NCDPS, ECRCO is referring this complaint to your office for appropriate action. We have notified Complainant and NCDPS that this complaint is being forwarded to DOJ and provided your contact information. A copy of our letter to Complainant as well as the original complaint are enclosed.
