APPLICANT

The applicant for this project is Maverick Boat Group, Inc. The applicant's responsible official and mailing address are: Christopher Gratz, President, Maverick Boat Group, Inc., 3207 Industrial 29th Street, Fort Pierce, Florida 34946.

FACILITY DESCRIPTION

The applicant operates the existing Maverick Boats, which is in St. Lucie County at 3207 Industrial 29th Street in Fort Pierce, Florida.

Maverick Boats is an existing boat manufacturing facility that is comprised of two separate locations. The main facility (Production Line No. 1) is located at 3207 Industrial 29th Street in Fort Pierce, Florida, and the second facility (Production Line Nos. 2 and 3) is located at 4551 St. Lucie Boulevard in Fort Pierce, Florida, approximately one mile from the main facility. The existing boat manufacturer produces fiberglass boats and consists of the following activities: lamination; assembly; tooling; warehouse; and miscellaneous small parts and tooling activities.

This facility also includes miscellaneous insignificant emissions units and/or activities.

PRIMARY REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS

Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) Code: 3732 – Boat Building and Repairing.

North American Industry Classification System (NAICS): 336612 – Boat Building.

HAP: The facility is identified as a major source of hazardous air pollutants (HAP).

Title V: The facility is a Title V major source of air pollution in accordance with Chapter 62-213, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). Facility-wide potential emissions of volatile organic compounds (VOC) exceed 100 tons/year and facility-wide potential emissions of styrene (a HAP) exceed 10 tons/year.

PSD: The facility is a Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD)-major source of air pollution in accordance with Rule 62-212.400, F.A.C.

NESHAP: The facility operates units subject to the National Emissions Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) of 40 CFR 63.

CAM: Compliance Assurance Monitoring (CAM) does not apply to any of the units at the facility.

GHG: The facility is not identified as a major source of greenhouse gas (GHG) pollutants.

PROJECT REVIEW

1. Permit formats were updated to their most recent versions.
2. Federal appendices were updated to their most recent versions.
3. Various typographical errors were corrected.
4. Electronic reporting requirements for the EPA are now included for boat manufacturers under 40 CFR 63.5765. These requirements are added as Specific Conditions A.27 and B.27, respectively.
5. The requirements from Subpart VVVV were added for carpet and fabric adhesive operations. The standard is included under Specific Conditions A.8 and B.8, and the recordkeeping requirements are included under Specific Conditions A.23 and B.23.

CONCLUSION

This project renews Title V Air Operation Permit No. 1110086-014-AV, which was effective on July 15, 2020. This Title V air operation permit renewal is issued under the provisions of Chapter 403, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Chapters 62-4, 62-210, and 62-213, F.A.C.
