

EPA Oversight of RED HILL Environmental Investigation and Remediation

EPA continues to oversee the environmental investigation and remediation work as part of **Phase II Closure** of the Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Tanks to ensure releases are cleaned up in a manner that is protective of human health and the environment.

EPA:

- Directs the investigation and cleanup of known releases of petroleum and other contaminants since 2014
- Reviews site assessment plan to identify where where historical releases occurred
- Oversees soil vapor and groundwater monitoring
- Guides the expansion of the groundwater monitoring well network
- Evaluates remedial pilot studies of known releases near Adit 3







Completed/Ongoing

EPA will:

- Ensure NCTF continues its identification of potential Red Hill releases
- Review site assessment data to ensure NCTF identifies release locations for further investigation and clean-up
- Guide additional sampling to define the nature & extent of identified releases
- Direct an assessment of the risk to human health and the environment from all releases
- Evaluate the effectiveness of various remedial technologies as other impacted areas are identified
- Oversee implementation of selected remedial technology to clean up contamination
