



Oversight of Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam Public Water System

EPA continues to review all of Navy's drinking water data including the recently-completed Extended Drinking Water Monitoring (EDWM) program. To date, all final samples from each location have met Federal drinking water standards and incident specific parameters. In addition, EPA has overseen upgrades to the Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam drinking water system under the 2023 Administrative Consent Order.

EPA:

- Approved EDWM and incorporated plan into the 2023 Administrative Consent Order (ACO), making it enforceable [Oct 2024].
- Reviewed and approved Navy's Asset Management Plan that prioritizes critical infrastructure for maintenance, repairs, and replacements [Nov 2024].
- Conducted inspection of JBPHH drinking water system in June 2024 to assess compliance with ACO and published the final report [Sep 2024].
- Completed an audit of Navy's field sampling practices, ensuring proper sample collection procedures.

Upcoming Work

Completed/Ongoing Work

EPA will:

- Conduct analysis of split samples to validate Navy's EDWM sampling.
- Finalize an EPA summary report of drinking water investigations by end of Summer 2025.
- Review and ensure adequacy of a flushing plan in late 2025 or early 2026 to remove sediment from pipes and; to improve water quality and drinking water system resilience.
- Review Navy's complaint investigation Standard Operating Plan in Spring 2025 to ensure in-field investigations are conducted thoroughly.
