Dear Mr. Kesterholt:

The EPA is currently reviewing your renewal application and supplemental information for the PCB authorization submitted through March 25, 2025, for compliance with the Toxic Substances Control Act, 40 CFR 761.75. In addition, the EPA is fulfilling its obligations under the Endangered Species Act and the National Historic Preservation Act.

In order to allow for full consideration and review of your submitted information and any subsequent public participation, the EPA is extending your current approval pursuant to regulations issued under section 6(e) of the Toxic Substances Control Act and codified in 40 CFR Parts 750 and 761. The EPA finds that extending your current approval for disposal of PCBs at CSC Landfill until November 30, 2025, does not present an unreasonable risk of injury to health or the environment.
