

NPDES authorization to discharge to waters of the United States, Permit No. NM0031231

The permittee is authorized to discharge from a facility located at 1 Giant Crossing, Jamestown in McKinley County, New Mexico. The proposed point of discharge from the treatment plant is in the dry swale immediately ahead of the 7 corrugated pipe road culvert at coordinates. Effluent is disinfected with ultraviolet system before discharge via Outfall 001, an intermittent Puerco River, New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC) section 20.6.4.98, into the South Fork Puerco River, an intermittent stream, thence the Puerco River, an intermittent portion to the Gallup WWTP, thence to the Puerco River, perennial reach, and thence to the little Colorado river basin. The designated uses of all intermittent surface water (Section 20.6.4.98 NMAC) are livestock watering, wildlife habitat, marginal warmwater aquatic life and primary contact.

The Pilot Travel Center #305 is a transient, noncommunity water and wastewater service provider. The facility provides twenty-four-hour services for drivers traveling along Interstate 40 in Jamestown, New Mexico.

Under the SIC code 4952, the applicant plans to operate a WWTP, which has a design flow of 0.050 MGD, with a current annual average flow rate of 0.033 MGD, serving a total population of 10,000 per day.

This is a first-time permit issuance. A Statement of Basis is available.

State Certification

This Notice also serves as Public Notice of the intent of the New Mexico Environment Department, Surface Water Quality Bureau to consider issuing Clean Water Act (CWA) Section 401 Certification.
