In recognition of the BP Products North America's efforts to investigate the Former Pan American/Amoco Refinery (the "Property"), the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality (LDEQ) and the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region 6 have together determined that the Property is Ready for Reuse. As documented in the Ready for Reuse Determination Letter of April 8, 2008, a Ready for Reuse Determination is an acknowledgement that environmental conditions on the Property are protective of human health and the environment based on its current and anticipated future use as a commercial/industrial operation.
