SUBJECT: Reallotment of Fiscal Year 2022 (2nd Round) and Fiscal Year 2023 Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act Clean Water State Revolving Fund Emerging Contaminants Funds

This memorandum announces the availability of reallotted federal fiscal year (FY) 2022 and 2023 Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) dollars. These funds originated from P.L. 117-58, also known as the “Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act of 2021” (IIJA). This action makes additional emerging contaminant funds available to states across the nation.

In 2024, two states declined their FY 2023 CWSRF IIJA Emerging Contaminant (EC) capitalization grants. The EPA is working closely with these states so that they can successfully apply for future years of funding for this program. Because these funds were declined, \$5,005,000 remains unobligated. By law, the EPA must reallot unobligated funds after the second fiscal year of availability. The process is explained in the September 11, 2020, memorandum, “[State Revolving Fund Capitalization Grant Reallotment Procedure](#).”

In 2024, several states and territories declined their portion of the FY 2022 CWSRF IIJA Emerging Contaminant reallotment. The remaining balance of \$185,000 will be reallotted consistent with the September 11, 2020, memorandum, “[State Revolving Fund Capitalization Grant Reallotment Procedure](#).”

Per statute, recipients that declined funding or did not receive the full CWSRF IIJA EC allotment (including 604(b) funds) within the first federal fiscal year of availability are ineligible for FY 2023 reallotted funds. Likewise, only recipients that accepted their full FY 2022 IIJA reallotment are eligible to participate in the 2nd round reallotment of these funds.

Eligible states, Puerto Rico, the District of Columbia, and the territories have until September 30, 2025, to apply for and receive their portion of the reallotted funds. Any available funds remaining unawarded after that date will be available for reallotment.

These reallotted funds carry all program requirements and authorities associated with the FY 2022 and FY 2023 IIJA EC appropriations and all current statutory requirements. Please see the abovementioned September 2020 reallotment memorandum for details about mechanisms Regions may use to award the funds.
