Dear Mr. Breton:

By this letter, the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) is terminating the above referenced permit last issued on September 18, 2015 to Vassalboro Sanitary District (VSD) for their Cemetery Street facility. The permit authorized the discharge of 0.029 MGD from June 1st to September 30th and 0.043 MGD from October 1st – May 31st of secondary treated sanitary wastewater from the Cemetery St. facility to Outlet Stream, Class B in Vassalboro.

Based on a letter received by the Department on August 26, 2020 from you to me, it is our understanding you are requesting to terminate said WDL as the VSD has constructed a new pump station to direct all Cemetery St. flows to the Town of Winslow collection system (ultimately flowing to the Kennebec Sanitary Treatment District (KSTD)). This was confirmed by Department staff via site inspection following the closure and relayed to me via email on February 12, 2021.

The Department will be inactivating the facility in our database so that Discharge Monitoring Reports and billing statements are not sent to the licensee in the future. By copy of this letter, we are notifying the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency of the retirement of the license.

Please be advised that a license may be needed from Department for any future discharge of pollutants from this facility to the surface or ground waters of the State of Maine, either under current ownership or new ownership. Any new permit/license would be based on the characteristics of the effluent being discharged and the impacts of the discharge on the quality of the receiving water.
