Dear Mr. Boyle:

The Department of Environmental Conservation's (DEC) Watershed Management Division received an email from Scott Boyle of Energizer, on June 28, 2021, indicating that discharge permit 3-1163 is no longer required since the manufacturing facility has closed.

Discharge permit 3-1163 was still active under Title 3, Section 814 at the time termination was requested. A final prorated invoice was paid in full subsequent to your request to terminate the permit.

We have received all the required monitoring data (WR-43s).

Based upon the information provided, the facility's discharge permit will be inactivated. If facility operations in the future entail the discharge of process wastewater to waters of the State, the Permittee must notify the Agency and apply for a discharge permit.

### Findings of Fact

1. The facility is engaged in the manufacturing of batteries.
2. The discharge permit for the facility expired on December 31, 2012. An application for permit renewal was submitted on July 2, 2007, and the discharge permit was extended under Title 3, Section 814.
3. On June 28, 2021, the permittee submitted a formal request for discharge permit termination.
4. On July 14, 2021, David DiDomenico reviewed the water quality discharge records for the facility.
5. On August 2, 2021, the permittee submitted all water quality discharge records for 2021 and paid the balance for operating fees due for 2021.
6. The Permittee is currently up to date on payments.
7. There are no compliance issues outstanding.

Based on these facts the facility's discharge permit will be inactivated.
