Re: EPA Pretreatment Notification of Categorial Industrial User Requirements, ICIS Number: CO-PF00101

Dear Mr. Brooks:

The EPA conducted a Pretreatment facility inspection of Jabil Incorporated on February 26, 2025 and determined that significant changes have occurred at the facility since the Notice of Discharge Requirements (NDR) was initially issued to the facility in 2020. As a result, the fact sheet and the NDR were modified to reflect current facility conditions for production levels, wastewater treatment system configuration, volume of non-regulated wastestreams discharged to outfall 001, and as a result of these changes, a re-calculation of NDR limits based on the combined wastestream formula.

Jabil Incorporated is an industrial user of the Monument Sanitation District's publicly owned treatment works (POTW), which does not have a Pretreatment Program approved by EPA. Therefore, EPA Region 8 serves as the Control Authority and directly oversees compliance of industrial users that discharge to the Monument Sanitation District's POTW and is partnering with the District to ensure its POTW is protected from potential impacts of pollutants discharged from non-domestic sources. The fact sheet and NDR modifications were public noticed on the EPA's website on June 16, 2025 for a 30-day public comment period. There were no substantive comments received.

Nothing contained in this notification package or in any EPA regulations restrict state or local agencies from imposing additional requirements in accordance with applicable laws, including requirements

which are more stringent than those imposed by the EPA. If you have any questions about the enclosed
