NOTICE: PREPARATION OF DRAFT NPDES PERMIT

Notice is hereby given that the following parties have applied to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) under the provisions of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. § 1251 et seq. (the Act), for National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permits for the discharge of pollutants into waters of the United States.

The applicant, EcoEléctrica, L.P., 641 Road 337, Peñuelas, Puerto Rico 00624, has applied for a permit for the following facility:

EcoEléctrica, L.P. is a liquefied natural gas (LNG) cogeneration power plant which consists of an LNG marine unloading and storage terminal, a cogeneration plant with two combustion turbines and two heat recovery steam generators inline with a stream turbine, a desalination plant and auxiliary diesel generator.

This notice is being given to inform the public that EPA has prepared a draft NPDES permit for the above referenced facility. The draft permit contains effluent limitations, standards, prohibitions, and other conditions necessary to carry out the provisions of the Act. If, after the conclusion of the proceeding summarized below, the Regional Administrator of Region 2 of EPA makes a final decision to issue the permits, the applicant will be required to comply with all the conditions in the permit.

The draft permits prepared by EPA are based on the respective administrative records. Among other documents, the administrative record required by 40 CFR § 124.9, consists of the application, draft NPDES permit, and statement of basis or fact sheet describing the basis for the conditions in the draft permit. All data submitted by the applicant is available as part of the administrative record.

A copy of the administrative record is on file at the EPA Region 2 Water Division office. To obtain files or make an appointment to view files, please contact Pylypchuk.sieglinde@epa.gov. The draft permit and fact sheet are also available on the EPA website at <https://www.epa.gov/npdes-permits/puerto-rico-npdes-permits>.

Interested persons may submit written comments on the draft permit via email to Region2_NPDES@epa.gov and Pylypchuk.sieglinde@epa.gov. Hard copy comments can be submitted to Josh Kogan, NPDES Section Supervisor, U.S. EPA Region 2, 290 Broadway, 24th Floor, New York, NY 10007. All comments must be submitted by September 14, 2025.

All persons may provide comments during the public comment period. If the EPA finds that timely submitted comments appear to raise substantial new questions, EPA may reopen the public comment period for that permit.

Any interested persons may request a public hearing on these documents. Any request for public hearing under 40 CFR § 124.11 on EPA's draft permits shall be in writing, state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing, and be submitted via email to Region2_NPDES@epa.gov and Pylypchuk.sieglinde@epa.gov, by no later than 30 days from the date of this notice.. Hard copy requests can be submitted to Josh Kogan, NPDES Section Supervisor, U.S. EPA Region 2, 290 Broadway, 24th Floor, New York, NY 10007. EPA's decision on the question of whether to hold a public hearing on the draft permit, the administration of any hearing and the rights and obligations of participants are governed by regulations at 40 CFR § 124.12. If EPA holds a public hearing, the public comment period described in this notice will be extended to the close of the public hearing.

If EPA does not hold a public hearing or reopen the comment period, EPA shall consider the issuance of a final permit to the applicant as soon as possible after the date indicated above for the submission for comments. All timely comments, submitted by interested persons in response to this notice, and statements and other evidence properly submitted at any public hearing held by EPA shall be considered in making the final decision with respect to this permit application. All comments shall be answered as provided in 40 CFR § 124.17.

The applicant and any other person who submits timely written comments or request notice of final permit decision shall receive notice of EPA's final decision. Within 30 days of service of such notice, any interested person who has submitted timely written comments may file a notice of appeal and petition for review to the Environmental Appeals Board to review any condition of the permit decision. Any person who failed to file comments or failed to participate in the public hearing on the draft permit may petition for review only to the extent of the changes from the draft to the final permit decision. Any such request must meet the requirements of 40 CFR § 124.19.
