SUMMARY: EPA is providing notice of a proposed Administrative Order on Consent to address violation of the Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA). EPA is also providing notice of opportunity to comment on the proposed Administrative Order on Consent.

Part C of the SDWA specifically mandates regulation of the underground injection of fluids through wells to ensure that the quality of underground sources of drinking water is protected. Section 1422 of the SDWA requires the EPA to administer Underground Injection Control ("UIC") programs in states that do not have approved UIC programs. New York has not acquired primacy over the UIC program pursuant to 40 C.F.R. Part 147 and, therefore, the EPA administers the program in New York.

The proposed Administrative Order on Consent seeks to address large-capacity cesspools, a Class V UIC well(s), owned and/or operated by Holbrook MTA Auto Service (Respondent) located at 397 Union Ave., #A, Holbrook, NY 11741. Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 144.88(a), large-capacity cesspools were required to be closed by April 5, 2005. The proposed Administrative Order on Consent establishes an enforceable schedule to eliminate the large-capacity cesspools, located at Holbrook MTA Auto Service.
