**[PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING EPA’S UNOPPOSED MOTION  
TO STAY COMPLAINT RESPONSE DEADLINES**

Upon consideration of EPA’s Unopposed Motion to Stay Complaint Response Deadlines (the “Motion”), ECF No. 113, it is hereby:

**ORDERED** that the Motion is **GRANTED**; it is further

**ORDERED** that Defendants’ deadline to respond to all complaints is stayed pending the D.C. Circuit’s mandate on the issues presented in EPA’s interlocutory appeal of the Court’s order granting a preliminary injunction (“PI Order”), ECF No. 80, as clarified, ECF No. 96; it is further

**ORDERED** that the Court will schedule a status conference following the issuance of the D.C. Circuit’s mandate under Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 41 to discuss how these consolidated cases will proceed.
