The U. S. Environmental Protection Agency Region 3 (EPA) proposes to issue a permit under the authority of the federal Underground Injection Control (UIC) regulations at 40 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) Parts 124, 144, 146, and 147 to EnerVest Operating, LLC (“EnerVest”).

Description: EnerVest applied for the renewal of one (1) UIC Class II injection well permit for the disposal of produced fluids associated with oil and gas production. The injection well will be located in the Nora and Oakwood Fields, Prater District, Buchanan County, Virginia. The draft permit will allow EnerVest to inject produced fluids into the Weir Formation in the subsurface interval between approximately 4,250 feet to 4,500 feet below ground surface. If the EPA issues the final permit to EnerVest, the permit will remain in effect for the operational life of the Facility. A permit is required to meet the provisions of the EPA-administered UIC Program in Virginia.

Tentative Public Hearing: The EPA has tentatively scheduled a virtual public hearing on December 8, 2025. An in-person hearing will not take place. The call-in and log-in information for the virtual meeting is listed below:
