

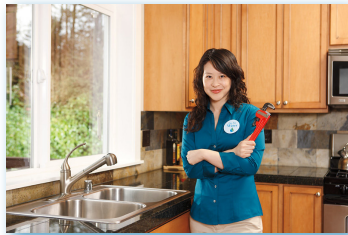

Pledge to Save Water All Year

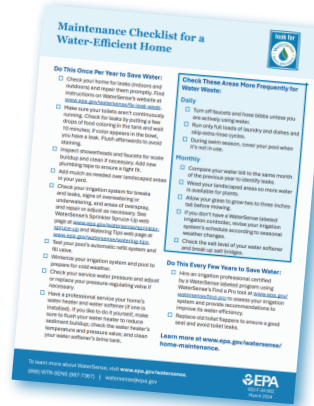


Take the “I’m for Water” pledge and use WaterSense’s Resolution Checklist to find easy ways to save water each month in 2026.

Five Tips to Fix a Leak Week



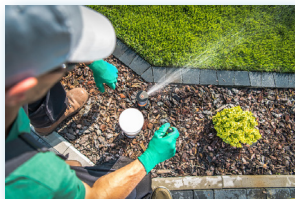
Check your home for wasteful and costly water leaks and stop them in their tracks!
