Opening, Introductions, Agenda Review

Presentation and Discussion regarding Red Hill Shaft and Navy Halawa Shaft

Representatives of the U.S. Navy will provide a short presentation that responds to questions posed by the CRI representatives regarding reopening of the Red Hill and Navy Halawa Shafts.

Representatives of the Hawaii Department of Health will share information about their regulatory oversight of shaft reopening.

Members of the CRI will share perspectives for Navy and DLA to consider regarding shaft reopening.

Update and Discussion regarding Tank Cleaning and Future of Tanks

Attendees will hear an update from the Navy and DLA about the tank cleaning program, and a review of the process to determine the future of the tank facility.

Members of the CRI will share perspectives for Navy and DLA to consider as cleaning and decision-making proceed.

Updates from Navy and DLA Responding to CRI Requests

Long-Term Remediation: Attendees will hear an update from the Navy and DLA about the strategy for long-term remediation of releases to the environment from the Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility.

Extended Drinking Water Monitoring Plan: Attendees will hear from the Navy and DLA about the conclusion of the Extended Drinking Water Monitoring Plan.

Communications with Residents: Attendees will hear from the Navy and DLA about their efforts to keep new residents informed, and an update on the program to respond to reports of issues from residents.
