Phosphogypsum Road Trial

Notification of Phosphogypsum Sampling Results

Dear Mr. Szabo:

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued its approval for a small-scale pilot road project at the Mosaic Fertilizer, LLC (Mosaic) New Wales facility on December 20, 2024. Condition 2 of the approval requires Mosaic to perform sampling that conforms with §61.207 on the actual phosphogypsum used for the project prior to its removal from the stack. Mosaic must submit the results of sampling for radium-226, including raw analytical data, to the EPA prior to the construction of the test road base containing phosphogypsum. Construction of the road base containing phosphogypsum is scheduled to begin September 15, 2025.

Please find the sampling results, including the raw analytical data, attached.
