The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued its approval for a small-scale pilot road project at the Mosaic Fertilizer, LLC (Mosaic) New Wales facility on December 20, 2024. Condition 3 of the approval requires Mosaic to submit the project schedule to EPA at least 30 days prior to beginning construction of the test road base. Please find the project schedule, which has August 18, 2025 as the expected construction start date attached. We do not expect construction to begin earlier than that date.

The project schedule is subject to change based on a variety of factors such as weather. Any significant changes will be reported during the project status update submittals.
