The Winnebago Tribe of Nebraska respectfully submits this supplemental request for Treatment as a State (TAS) under Clean Water Act (CWA) 518 to administer CWA 303(c) Water Quality Standards and CWA 401 Water Quality Certification. This request builds on the Tribe's prior TAS determination and reflects jurisdictional updates due to the Winnebago Land Transfer Act of 2023 (Public Law 118-68; signed July 12, 2024), which placed additional lands into trust and within the Tribe's Reservation, increasing our stewardship responsibilities over covered surface waters.
