Project Description

Midland had haloacetic acid (HAA5) concentrations over the maximum contaminant level (MCL), resulting in several Disinfectants and Disinfection Byproducts Rule (DBPR) violations. Midland constructed a new 54,000-gallon water storage facility with mixing system and installed over 3,000 linear feet (LF) of water mains to provide looping in the distribution system. This project replaced aging infrastructure and eliminated DBPR violations. **Midland's project utilized \$206,000 in DWSRF assistance and was completed in September 2017.**
