Project Description

Customers in the Central Hampshire Public Service District's (PSD) Green Spring and Springfield systems encountered water service interruption at a higher rate than normal due to the high frequency of line failures in the system. **To address this issue, the Central Hampshire PSD utilized approximately \$3 million in funding, including \$1.3 million in DWSRF assistance with \$555,000 in principal forgiveness, to rehabilitate water mains in the Springfield system and upgrade Green Spring's water treatment plant.** This project was completed in February 2020 and resulted in a more reliable system and improved drinking water quality for 3,500 residents.
