Project Description

Due to high nitrate concentrations in Lorayne J's wells, the City of Richland provided Lorayne J drinking water through an emergency intertie for several years. **In 2018, the City received \$1.8 million in DWSRF assistance with \$921,000 in principal forgiveness to consolidate the Lorayne J water system into its water system.** The City installed a permanent intertie with Lorayne J, in addition to other system upgrades, allowing Lorayne J's 116 households to abandon their high nitrate wells. The previous owner of Lorayne J will continue to provide residents with landscape irrigation water, reducing demand for the City's water.
