Project Description

After the Florida Department of Health (DOH) detected perfluorooctane sulfonate (PFOS) and perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA) in the private wells of 146 residents in the Monterey Subdivision, Martin County worked with City of Stuart leadership to determine a long-term solution. **Florida's Department of Environmental Protection and DWSRF collaborated to provide \$468,000 in a DWSRF loan principal forgiveness and a Florida Water Supply Restoration Program grant to disconnect the homes from the contaminated private wells and incorporate them into the City's drinking water system.** DOH hosted information sessions in both English and Spanish, so that all community members had the opportunity to be added to the City's water system and have access to safe drinking water.
