Project Description

For years, residents of the Freeport area in Wirt County petitioned the Claywood Park Public Service District (PSD) to be incorporated into the public water system. Approximately 100 residents in Freeport experienced poor water quality and unreliable water supplies. **Claywood Park PSD used \$1.2 million in funding, including \$637,000 from the DWSRF with \$196,000 in principal forgiveness and additional funding from the West Virginia Infrastructure and Jobs Development Council to extend water service to the residents in the Freeport area.**
