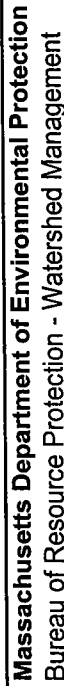

ENDANGERED SPECIES

Endangered species in Bristol County, of which Easton is a part, is listed in Federal Register/Vol. 63, No. 31/Tuesday, February 17, 1998/Notices as follows:

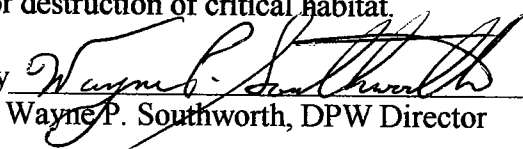

In addition, the Natural Heritage & Endangered Species Program identified 1999 – 2000 Estimated Habitats of Rare Wildlife for use with the Wetlands Protection Act Regulations (310 CMR 10) as follows:

WH 6070	Mulberry Brook between Highland Street and Fuller-Hammond Reservoir.
WH 331	East of Cranberry Bogs between Dean Street and the Easton/Norton town line.
WH 7260	Black Brook between Kennedy Circle to Prospect Street.
WH 528	Black Brook above Depot Street between Center Street and Black Brook Road.
WH 539	Adjacent to abandoned railroad between Depot Street and Prospect Street.
WH 7261	Cedar Swamp area between Purchase Street and Foundry Street.
WH 324	Queset Brook north of Depot Street at the Easton/W. Bridgewater town line.
WH 525	Queset Brook between Main Street and Short Street.
WH 4131	Queset Brook between Canton Street and Lincoln Street.

As stated in Criteria D, Using best judgment and knowledge, the effects of the storm water discharges, allowable non-storm water discharges, and discharge related activities on listed species and critical habitat have been evaluated. Based on those evaluations, a determination is made by the permittee that there is no reason to believe that the storm water discharges, allowable non-storm water discharges, and discharge related activities will jeopardize the continued existence of any species or result in the adverse modification or destruction of critical habitat.
