Project Description

The Town of Bethel had an aging water system that needed major rehabilitation. **As part of the water system upgrades, the town received \$2.2 million in DWSRF funding, with \$500,000 in principal forgiveness, for planning, design, and construction of a booster pump station and the Chestnut Ridge Water Storage Tank.** This project, completed in December 2020, was necessary to provide adequate system pressures and redundant storage volume, reduce disinfection byproducts, and improve drinking water for customers.
