The Town of Boylston completed it's application for permit and submitted it within the extended allowable time frame and to date have not received a notice of permit approval, however we do not wish to be out of compliance by not filing a timely annual report.

We have begun to apply our proposed phases of our plan as follows:

- ◆ Public Education:
 - Provided financial contribution to & Partnered with Suasco
 - Created cable network educational advertisements
 - Circulated Storm water Brochure through town
 - Made brochures are available in Town Hall
 - Signs posted at public parks for pet owners to properly dispose of waste
- ◆ Public Participation
 - Partnered with a Local organization
 - Traveling display at Town Hall for one month and now at Regional at High School
- ◆ Illicit Discharge Detection & Elimination
 - Drainage mapping preliminary information gathering in process



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- ♦ Municipal Good Housekeeping
 - Employee training on going
 - Catch Basin cleaning is done annually or more frequently as deemed necessary
 - Street Sweeping is done annually
 - Recycling Program: Highway Dept. does receive waste oil for proper disposal on an annual basis
