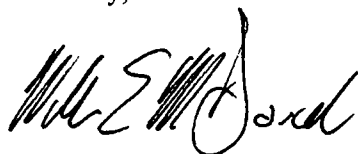

Part II. Self- Assessment

The Town of Stoughton has completed the required self-assessment and has determined that our municipality is in compliance with all permit conditions with the following exceptions:

Notice of Intent Section 1 – Public Education and Outreach – BMP’s # 2, 4

The Public Education and Outreach effort includes two tasks that are to be created with students at the High School both for purposes of including members of the community, and utilizing resources available to the High School that are not available to the Town, such as video recording and post production equipment. At this time, production has not yet begun on the creation of the video, but the committee anticipates the production will begin in the fall of 2006 with the beginning of the school year.

Notice of Intent Section 3 - Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination - BMP’s # 9, 10:

The Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination effort begins with mapping the existing drainage system. At this time, changes in staffing levels at the Town have eliminated three positions directly responsible for the mapping effort. Funding for a contractor to perform the survey work required to locate individual drain outfalls in the field has not been secured. The Engineering Department continues to pursue grants and other sources of funding. An RFP has been prepared and will be issued when a suitable source of funds has been secured.

Part IV. Summary of Information Collected and Analyzed

The Engineering Department has produced an RFP requesting proposals for town wide mapping. The Town has not agreed to use GIS money for the mapping effort. This has altered the resources available to perform tasks noted in the Notice of Intent. The Engineering Department and the Technical Review Committee are investigating funding mechanisms to contract the mapping portion of the Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination out. The Department is actively seeking grant money and preparing material for a warrant article on the next available Special Town Meeting. This has and will continue to delay the creation of the town-wide drainage system map, however, mapping of portions of the Town's drainage system using existing utility as-built plans and subdivision design plans is ongoing. The ultimate goal will not be delivered according to the schedule noted in the NOI but every effort is being made to meet the measurable goal prior to the expiration of the General Permit in May 2008.

The Town will vote on a Stormwater Management By-Law at the Annual Town Meeting commencing on May 1, 2006. The By-Law authorizes the Town to take action and remove illicit discharges and to enforce erosion control measures beyond the scope of Conservation Commission jurisdiction.
