The town of Westport has taken further strides to implement the NPDES OII Small MS4 General Permit. The town of Westport is not in compliance with the schedule requirements of the permit.

BMP 2-2: Storm Water Management Committee

The Board of Selectmen established a municipal Storm Water Management Program Committee to oversee the town's Phase II program. The committee is comprised of the following town officials: Town Administrator, Highway Surveyor and a representative from the Board of Health, Conservation Commission, and Planning Board. The committee has invited a representative of the Westport River Watershed Alliance to attend the meetings. Some members of this year's committee either are no longer involved with the Town of Westport or has difficulty making daytime meetings. A request for representatives from the various Boards/Committees had been made and a new committee will be established. The prior committee met three times during the course of the past year.
