Violation: [Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 \(pdf\)](#), which prohibits recipients of federal financial assistance from discriminating on the basis of race, color, or national origin.

Synopsis: Colorado Department of Health & Environment (CDPHE) discriminated against African American (Black) certified contractors by applying the rules of CDPHE Regulation 8 to said parties and not applying the rules to White contractors and official representatives in clear violation of the regulations as written. This complaint to the EPA External Civil Rights Division will bring to light the fifth specific incident that is recorded on tape and verifiable.

On October 9, 2025 – CDPHE and the State Attorney General Office conducted an investigation about the unpermitted removal of asbestos from a condominium. The actual perpetrator denied being on site. The actual perpetrator vehemently denied knowing about the incident until (b) (6) Privacy produced evidence of them being there.

As previously stated – this is the fifth incident of blatant rules violations by CDPHE documented by the parting filing this complaint.

The perpetrator in spite of the admission – was and is allowed to continue to work in Colorado under CDPHE Regulation 8. This allows the perpetrator to make hundreds of thousands of dollars. (b) (6) Privacy, (b) (7)(C) Enf. Privacy is still not able to practice this trade under CDPHE Regulation 8 due to CDPHE allowing certain individuals to practice who are not African American Black by unfairly applying the regulations.

Please be aware we are within the 180 day window of the violation taking place. Again – there are witnesses and tapes of all parties involved. This also involves the State Attorney Generals office. A complaint was filed with said office prior to this hearing. (b) (6) Privacy, (b) (7)(C) Enf. Privacy, a representative lawyer of the State Attorney General, failed to investigate complaints previously filed with his office against CDPHE before attending the hearing.

In summary – CDPHE biasedly applies rules to Black/African Americans and not to others. Any complicity or wrongdoing by (b) (6) Privacy, (b) (7)(C) Enf. Privacy stems from repeated misconduct by the governing agency CDPHE. The filing party has always sought to use the “Chain of Command” first and be a compliant citizen and business entity.

We are beseeching the EPA OCR to intervene and stop this misuse of government resources to harm citizens and put the good intentions of environmental regulation in question to the citizenry the laws are designed to protect.

Please note – this violation by CDPHE is at the hearing. CDPHE is breaching fair practices in the field and in hearings. Their violations have no boundaries. This hearing is within the 180 window of investigation window of the EPA OCR.
