

Notice of Issuance
Final HSWA Permit Modification to Ortho-Clinical Diagnostics Inc.

Raritan, New Jersey

The Director of the Land, Chemicals and Redevelopment Division (“Director”) of the United States Environmental Protection Agency (“EPA”), Region 2, has decided to issue a Permit Modification to the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments of 1984 (“HSWA”) Permit that EPA issued to Ortho-Clinical Diagnostics, Inc. (“Permittee”) in 1988, for its facility located at 1001 U.S. Route 202 North, Raritan, New Jersey 08869. This is a HSWA Permit Modification which, among other things, requires Permittee to continue cleanup measures for hazardous waste remaining at the facility, and makes a no further action determination for some units or areas of the facility where no additional cleanup work will be required. Enclosed is a copy of the final HSWA Permit Modification.

The public comment period for providing comments on the proposed permit modification lasted from September 5, 2025 through October 20, 2025, during which time any person could submit written comments to EPA regarding EPA’s tentative determinations and/or request a public hearing on the matter pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 124.12. An informational public meeting was held on October 6, 2025. Three commenters submitted comments on the proposed permit modification to EPA Region 2; there was no request for a public hearing. EPA’s Response to Comments submitted is attached to the final permit modification.

Anyone wishing to appeal the Director's decision should refer to the procedures set forth in 40 C.F.R. § 124.19. That section states that within thirty (30) days after the date of the service of this Notice, any person who filed comments on the proposed HSWA Permit Modification may file a petition (with respect to the issues raised in its previous comments) to the Environmental Appeals Board (EAB)¹ as provided in 40 C.F.R. § 124.19. Additionally, any person who failed to file comments on the proposed HSWA permit modification may petition for administrative review only to the extent of the changes from the proposed to the final permit decision. Furthermore, that section states that a person seeking appeal must exhaust administrative appeal procedures prior to invoking judicial review.

The thirty (30) day period to request review of this final permit decision shall begin with the date of the service of this Notice. (Note, for those parties receiving this Notice by mail, three (3) additional days will be added to the prescribed thirty (30) day period, as provided in 40 C.F.R. § 124.20(d).)
