

COMMON EPA MARKINGS

Signs you may see after EPA has visited wildfire-damaged properties



White signage and stake: household hazardous material removal has been completed at this site



White symbols (=, X, X↑) on trees: hangers or loose limbs, may be dangerous in high winds.

White "T": property assessed for trees



White paint or "X" mark: suspected empty hazardous material containers



Pink paint: suspected asbestos-containing material



Blue lightning bolt ⚡ indicates the date an electrician has visited a property



White "O" on vehicle hood: low voltage battery

White "X" on vehicle hood: battery removed

Blue lightning bolt: damaged electric vehicle (EV)

White and blue lightning bolt: EV battery removed



Red "X" on Battery Storage Systems: needs removal

White "X" on top of red "X": removal complete



Orange paint: septic system location, damaged transformer, or high hazard item left on site
