Thank you for the August 28, 2025, memorandum, which outlines the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's planned corrective actions and estimated completion dates for the one unresolved recommendation issued in the subject Office of Inspector General report. The other three recommendations were previously resolved. The unresolved recommendation, number 4, was to provide annual training to South Carolina staff on the Clean Water State Revolving Fund program to enhance knowledge of program requirements. The response described your office's completed FY 2025 training and ongoing FY 2026 training, and we reviewed subsequent information and supporting documentation to verify these actions. We agree that the corrective actions meet the intent of Recommendation 4. All recommendations for the subject report are now considered resolved. Your office should track implementation of the corrective actions in the Agency's audit tracking system until all actions are completed.
