RE: Climate Pollution Reduction Grant


Dear Environmental Protection Agency,

I write to confirm that the City of Eagan is part of the coalition proposal for commercial energy efficiency being submitted by the City of Minneapolis as the lead entity for the Climate Pollution Reduction Grant.

The proposal is to provide free energy audits through Energy Smart, a program of the Minnesota Chamber of Commerce, for commercial, industrial, business, and nonprofit properties. Following the assessment, energy efficiency recommendations will be made to the participating properties and funds will be available to match existing rebates and tax credits to encourage completion of the work.
