The Maryland Department of the Environment submits this letter of support for the State of New Jersey's coalition application entitled "Clean Corridor Coalition (C3)" in response to EPA's Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) No. EPA-R-OAR-CPRGI-23-07. As required by the NOFO, as a member of the coalition we intend to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and the other members of the coalition that sets forth the specific roles and responsibilities of each partner agency as well as the other information called for by the NOFO. The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection expects to submit this MOA no later than July 1, 2024.

Maryland is pleased to join New Jersey, Delaware, and Connecticut in this coalition application for funding zero-emission freight truck charging infrastructure along the I-95 corridor and adjacent roadways from Connecticut to Maryland.
