Greetings New Mexico Environment Department (NMED),

Greenlane Infrastructure, LLC (Greenlane) is a joint venture between Daimler Truck North America, NextEra Energy Resources, and BlackRock Alternatives, and was created to design, develop, install and operate a nationwide, high-performance zero-emission public charging and hydrogen fueling network for medium- and heavy-duty (MHD) battery-electric and hydrogen fuel cell vehicles. Greenlane stands in support of all three of New Mexico's measures under their CPRG Implementation grant application. Greenlane is especially interested in New Mexico's first measure, Clean I-40 Transportation Corridor. Each of these measures will reduce air pollution, bring environmental benefits to the community, create vast workforce opportunities in and around New Mexico, and help Greenlane expand its network of zero emission infrastructure for MHD electric vehicles. Measure 1: Clean Transportation Corridor poses a unique opportunity for New Mexico, Arizona, and Oklahoma to transition local and national freight to zero emission ahead of the national adoption curve.

Greenlane's involvement with the project includes being a potential applicant to New Mexico's potential request for proposals (RFP) to implement their Clean I-40 Transportation Corridor measure. If New Mexico receives funding from EPA's CPRG for Measure 1, Greenlane anticipates responding to the expected RFP to solicit companies to build the zero emission infrastructure projects. Greenlane's support will allow NMED to implement the measure more effectively by implementing the zero emission infrastructure projects across the I-40 in Arizona, New Mexico, and Oklahoma.

In conclusion, Greenlane urges NMED to apply for the Climate Pollution Reduction Grant opportunity to support this measure and requests the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to award the funds to support it.
