The San Diego County Air Pollution Control District (SDAPCD) is providing this letter of commitment to the San Diego Association of Government's (SANDAG's) CPRG Phase II application for the "Decarbonizing the San Diego Region" Project (Project). SDAPCD is a government agency that monitors regional air quality and regulates sources of air pollution within San Diego County.
